David Frances L. Kerr
Born January 30, 1828 Abbeville, South Carolina
Died May 16, 1864 Drewry's Bluff, Virginia
Buried in Wedowee, Alabama in Randolph County at Wedowee Masonic Cemetery

Enlisted as First Corporal of Captain Hendricks Company in Alabama in Randolph County April 5, 1862

Captain Hendrick's Company was designated Company A of the Second Battalion of Hilliard's Legion

Elected Second Lieutenant November 12, 1862

Detached Duty Status as a Recruiter in his home town of Wedowee, Alabama in Randolph County From August 1, 1863 to October 1, 1863

After heavy losses at Chickamauga, Georgia Captain Hendrick's Company A of the Second Battalion of Hilliard's Legion was disbanded as a Military unit on November 25, 1863

Captain Hendrick's Company was designated Company A of the Second Battalion of Hilliard's Legion was reorganized into the Fifty Ninth and Sixtieth Alabama Infantry Regiments of the Confederate States of America

David Frances L. Kerr then served as a Second Lieutenant of Company F of the Fifty Ninth and Sixtieth Alabama Infantry Regiment of the Confederate States of America

Wounded in Action at engagement at Bean's Station in Tennessee in December 14, 1863

Killed in Action at Drewry's Bluff along the James River May 16, 1864
