We left Little Rock on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of this month and came down to this place and since we arrived been very busy ---This Company left home (*Houston County*) the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 1862 and has been near little Rock most of the time since. Francis (*Satterwhite*) and John W. Fambrough (*Celia Sattewhite's Husband*) are with me.--Alec has been drafted since we left. Louisa's (*Satterwhite*) husband, (*Washington*) was in service at Corinth last spring and was discharged.--Write me when you get this. You may direct your letter to Captain D. A. Nunn's Calvary Company, Arkadelphia, Arkansas."
