William J. Satterwhite was born in Georgia on July 28, 1825

Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite daughter of Eli McKinney: and future wife of William J. was born in Alabama on September 22, 1832

Jesse Floyd Mathews future son-in-law of William J. was born in Georgia on August 10, 1845

William J. married Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite Alabama in Chambers County on December 19, 1850

William J. and Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite had their first child John Madeson Satterwhite in Georgia in Troup County on May 1, 1852

William J. and Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite had their second child Sarah Florence Satterwhite Mathews in Alabama on January 7, 1853

William J. and Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite had their third child Martha Alzada Satterwhite Davis in Alabama on September 3, 1854

Dora Franklin Davis future son-in-law of William J.: and husband of Catherine Callie Rebecca Satterwhite Davis was born on July 25, 1855

William J. and Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite had their fourth child Catherine Callie Rebecca Satterwhite Davis in Georgia on December 17, 1855

William J. and Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite had their fifth child Permelia Mealy A. Satterwhite who died in her teens in Georgia on August 29, 1856

Zachariah Newton Newt Lipham future son-in-law of William J.: and husband of Mary Fannie Satterwhite Lipham was born in Georgia in Heard County on September 2, 1858

William J. Satterwhite appeared at dwelling 112, page 16, Northern Division; Pea Ridge Post Office, Randolph County, Alabama; is 35, married to Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite, and he is farming. Four children are with them. They live near Yancy Manning Satterwhite (William J.'S brother) and his family. On the Census of June 9, 1860

William J. and Sarah Elizabeth McKinney Satterwhite had their sixth child Mary Frances *Fannie* Satterwhite Lipham in Alabama on December 5, 1860

William J. died in Chattanooga, Tennessee in Hamilton County at Academy Hospital from Pneumonia on April 22, 1863

William J. was first buried in Chattanooga, Tennessee in Hamilton County near the Tennessee River shortly after his death

William J. was moved to Citizen Cemetery in Chattanooga, Tennessee in Hamilton County in 1867

William J.'s name appeared on a list compiled by R. L. Watkins in 1867

Rebecca **Manning** Satterwhite **mother of William J. died in Pine Mountain, Georgia in Troup County after fifty one years of marriage to Elijah on August 14, 1870**

Martha Alzada **Satterwhite** Davis **daughter of William J. married James Ralston Davis about 1872**

John Madeson Satterwhite son of William J. first Married Mary Fannie Norred Satterwhite September 27, 1877

Sarah Elizabeth **McKinney** Satterwhite **William J.'S wife appeared at S. D. 2; E.D. 107; sheet 6 B, Rockdale Beat number 3, Randolph County, Alabama; is alone with two of her children. John M. Satterwhite (William J.'S son) is a few doors away on the Census of June 30, 1880**

Mary Frances *Fannie* **Satterwhite** Lipham **married Zachariah Newton *Newt* Lipham before 1882**

John Madeson Satterwhite Son of William J. second married Lydia E Hollaway Satterwhite on August 29, 1882

Lydia E **Hollaway** Satterwhite **was buried at Foster's Crossroads in Alabama in Randolph County at Valley Grove Primitive Baptist Church Cemetery shortly after her death**

William Elijah Satterwhite son of William J. married Arizona A. Kerr Satterwhite about 1884

John Madeson Satterwhite son of William J. third Married Mary Elizabeth Smith Satterwhite about 1885

Elijah father of William J. died in Georgia on August 28, 1885

Sarah Florence **Satterwhite** **daughter of William J. married Jesse Floyd Mathews before 1890**

Catherine *Kallie* Rebecca **Satterwhite** Davis **daughter of William J. died in Arab, Alabama in Marshall County on June 6, 1896**

James Ralston Davis son-in-law of William J. died in Alabama in Cullman County on June 20, 1896

Catherine *Callie* Rebecca Satterwhite Davis was buried in Arab, Alabama in Marshall County at Arab City Cemetery shortly after her death

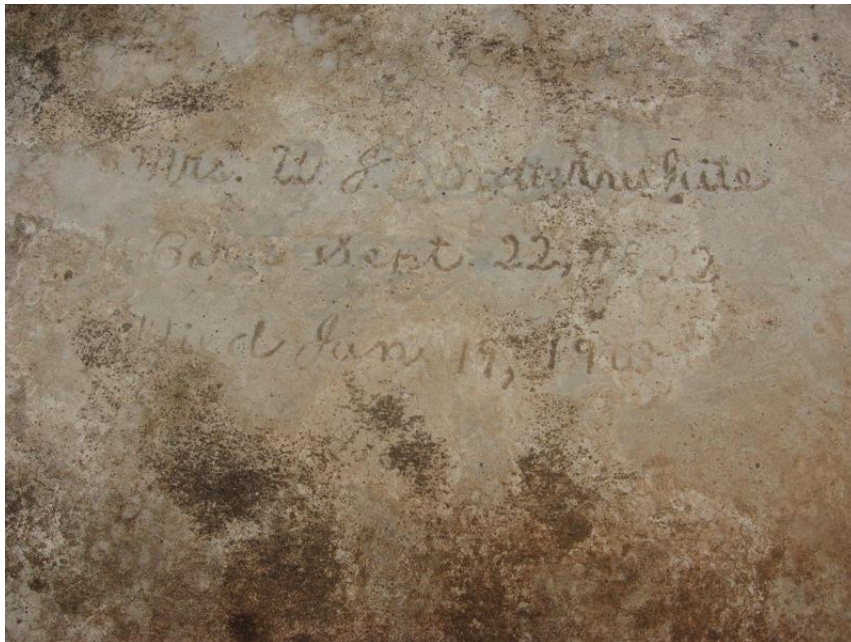

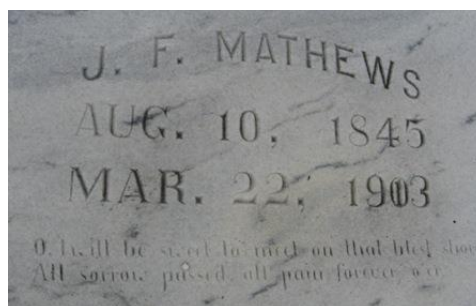
